_____ The finished barn quilt must be approved by the Franklin County Barn Quilt Committee in order to be included on the Barn Quilt Trail and accompanying publicity materials.

_____ The barn/structure site is visible from the road/water or on a site that is frequently visited. The Franklin County Barn Quilt Committee must approve placement location.

_____ I recognize that having a quilt block as part of the Franklin County Barn Quilt Trail may increase traffic and/or visitors to its location.

_____ The quilt block is the property of the owner. I will allow my barn/structure to be photographed by the public. Franklin County Barn Quilt Committee will have promotional rights, i.e. postcards, photos, calendars to any quilt block on the Franklin County Quilt Trail.

_____ The quilt block must remain on the structure for at least 3 years in order to be included on the Barn Quilt Trail and I will be responsible for any repairs or upkeep needed.

_____ The Franklin County Barn Quilt Committee must be notified if the quilt block is removed, becomes too deteriorated, needs to be repaired or renewed so that it can be removed from the publicity materials.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Franklin County Barn Quilt Committee, as well as the County of Franklin, its officers, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of action.
