## Rail Fence Quilt

This kit includes 6 strips each of fabrics A, B and C, 5 strips for border and 1 piece of backing fabric.

\*Fabric requirements: 1/2 yd. fabric A

1/2 yd. fabric B 1/2 yd. fabric C 3/4 % yd border fabric

11/2 yds. of backing fabric

1/2 bending


\*Cutting instructions: From fabric A cut six 21/2" wide strips

From fabric B cut six 2½" wide strips From fabric C cut six 2½" wide strips

From border fabric, cut five 356 strips

62" STRIPS


Using a  $\frac{\chi}{}$  seam allowance throughout, sew fabric strips A to fabric strips B and then to fabric strips C. Press seams. Measure the width of the sewn strip ( $\chi$ ") and cut sections that are exactly same dimension. (This will be about 6½".)









Cut thirty of these squares. Sew into rows of five squares with the fabric arranged in the diagrams of rows 1 and 2. You will have three rows of each arrangement.



Sew rows together alternating

Row 1 and Row 2 to form the center of
the quilt. Sew the border strips to the
longer sides of the rectangle piecing two
strips together if necessary. Then sew
the shorter sides.
