



July 21- 9-2 full day workshop presented by Lori Clayton from Threads Run Through It—The workshop will teach a new technique for cutting curves with a rotary cutter--making and appliqueing curved shapes onto projects. Sign ups will be at the June 3 meeting. Cost of the workshop will be \$10.

This beautiful curved diamond quilt requires:

- •The Sue Pelland- Grande Leaves Galore Template (with 4" and 8" curves) cost \$25.95
- •Hope's Diamond Quilt Pattern-cost \$9.45.
- •Lori will bring these items for purchase on the day of the workshop.

 The cost of the template can be shared with a friend if 2 members want to work together on their projects using one template.

July 22- 1PM Meeting program- Lori Clayton- Threads Run Through It will present a program on Perfect Points. Lori will demonstrate how to not only make perfect points but also have them come together into perfect blocks.

August 26th 1PM Program: Kathy Berinholtz, a local fiber artist, will present a lecture on "Hand Dyed Fabrics". She will explain several ways you can add color and interesting details to your fabric for quilting. Kathy is a multi-talented artist with a shop called "Vermillion" located inside the Artfully Framed shop here at the lake. We look forward to a great program from Kathy with loads of new fun ideas.

Workshop Guidelines

Workshops are special opportunities for a small group of people (usually only 20) to have instruction from a guest teacher. Please follow these guidelines when signing up for a workshop.

- Sign-up will begin at 12:30 p.m. at the guild meeting in the month announced for the workshop sign-up.
- Only people who have signed-up **AND** paid can attend the work-shop. You are not considered "signed-up" until you pay your money!
- If you are unable to attend the guild meeting at which the sign-up occurs, have a friend sign you up and pay your money. We will NOT be taking phone sign-ups before this time. Please don't ask us to break this rule.
- Once the workshop is filled, a waiting list will be formed. If someone drops out of the class, the next person on the waiting list will be called. Please do not by-pass the waiting list by selling your spot to a friend. It is not fair to those who have been put on the waiting list.
- •Once you are on the list, and find you will be unable to attend, you will not get a refund unless someone is found to take your place. Please contact Becky Linkous and Denise Pilversack as soon as you know you can't come and the next person on the waiting list will be called. If there is no one on the waiting list, you may then find your own replacement.
